jersey knight	Requires 2-3 years to establish before harvesting. Perennial. Hybrid
<b>Beans</b>	
provider	Early and very productive bush bean.
<b>Beets</b>	
detroid dark red	Uniform and smooth dark red beet. Large green tops are great for eating. Heirloom
<b>Brussels Sprouts</b>	
jade cross	28" tall plants produce 3/4 - 1" deep green brussels sprouts. Hybrid
<b>Broccoli</b>	
packman	Tight dome-shaped heads. Great side-shoot production. Stores well and grows well in the heat. Hybrid
<b>Cabbage</b>	
bravo	Large round heads are a beautiful blue-green color. Produces well in the Northeast. Hybrid.
savoy	Medium sized round, dark green heads with curly leaves. Hybrid
stonehead	3-4 lb. round light green heads. Hold well in the field without splitting. Disease resistant. Hybrid
late flat dutch	8 lb. firm flat heads good for storage. Heirloom
ruby perfection	Medium-sized round heads with consistent red color inside and out. Resists splitting in the field. Hybrid

snowcrown	Medium-sized heads, early and adaptable. Good as a summer or fall crop. Hybrid
<b>Cucumbers</b>	
lemon	3" round fruit resemble lemons. Ripens from pale greenish yellow to light yellow. Crisp and sweet. Heirloom
burpless	10" long mild slicing cucumber, can be picked young for pickling. Prefers to grow on a trellis. Hybrid
picklebush	2 ft. long vines great for small spaces. 4" long crisp tender cucumber great for pickling. Hybrid
eureka (pickling or slicing)	Very disease resistant. Can be eaten small for pickles or left to grow larger for slicing. Hybrid
bush champion	Great for small spaces. 8" long slicing cucumbers on tiny plants with good disease resistance. Hybrid
straight eight	Uniform 8" long deep green slicing cucumber. Does well on a trellis.. Heirloom
diva	5-7" seedless cucumbers don't require pollination, can be grown under cover. Hybrid

orient express	8-10" long slender asian type eggplant. Tender and quick-cooking with few seeds. Hybrid

<b>Ground Cherries</b>	
Aunt Molly's	1/2" fruits are enclosed in a papery husk, drop to the ground when fully ripe. Very sweet and citrusy. Heirloom
<b>Kale</b>	
darkibor	Curly and dark green leaves. Produces all season with continuous harvesting. Hybrid
<b>Kohlrabi</b>	
purple vienna	18" tall plant with mild turnip-cabbage flavor. Leaves and bulb are both edible. Heirloom
early white vienna	Bulbs have mild turnip-cabbage flavor and are most tender when size of an apple. Stores well. Heirloom
<b>Leeks</b>	
king richard	Long, white shaft with dark green leaves. Produces early but can hold well in the garden. OP
<b>Lettuce and Salad Greens</b>	
romaine	Head lettuce with thick crisp leaves. Slow to bolt. Can be grown in spring, summer and fall.
buttercrunch	Bibb-type lettuce with rich green leaves. Slow to bolt. Needs lots of water.
skyphos	Beautiful dark red butterhead with green centers. Very tender.
arugula	Slightly spicy greens great for salads or for cooking.
space spinach	Smooth to slightly savoyed leaves. Great for salads or for cooking. Hybrid
<b>Melons</b>	
sugar baby watermelon	Compact vines with small 8-10 lb. fruit. Very sweet and quick to mature in 78 days. Heirloom
sarah's choice cantaloupe	3 lb. fruit is juicy, tender, and extra sweet. 76 days to maturity. Hybrid
<b>Peas</b>	
sugarsnap	Deliciously sweet with an edible pod. Great raw or cooked. Tall vines need trellising. Heirloom
oregon giant snow	Productive and sweet edible-pod snow pea. Great raw or cooked. Vines grow 30" tall.
<b>Peppers Hot</b>	
ancho san martin	Mildly hot, 5 1/2" long dark green pepper. Good for stuffing and roasting. Hybrid
red rocket cayenne	Thin-walled 5-6" long chilis great for drying. Medium heat level.
bangkok thai chili	Small plants and small fruit are very ornamental. Spicy. Heirloom

hungarian wax	Medium hot, 5" long pepper ripens from yellow to orange-red. Good for canning.
inferno	Hot banana, 8" long pepper ripens from yellow to red. Hybrid
lg red cherry hot	Very hot, 2" long red pepper, very prolific.
jalapeno	Hot, 3 1/2" long deep green pepper.
bhut jolokia or ghost pepper	The world's hottest pepper, thin-walled, wrinkled fruits 2-3" in length, ripening mostly to red. Heirloom
trinidad scorpion	Second hottest chili on the planet! Wrinkled, lantern-shaped fruits ripen to red. Heirloom

big berthia	7" long red sweet pepper w/ thick walls. Large plants produce large fruit
california wonder	Blocky 4" x 3 1/2" sweet red bell pepper. Heirloom
cubanelle	7" long tapered sweet pepper with thin walls. Ripens from yellow-green to orange-red. Good for frying. OP
early sunsation	Blocky, large, golden-yellow sweet bell pepper.
gypsy	4" x 2" sweet pepper ripens from greenish yellow to orange and red. Good for frying or in salads
king arthur	Large, blocky, thick-walled pepper ripens from green to bright-red. Disease resistant. Hybrid
lady bell	Large, 3 to 4 lobed very prolific sweet red bell pepper. Good for the Northeast. Hybrid
purple beauty	3" x 3" blocky deep reddish-purple sweet bell pepper. OP
new ace	Thin-walled bell pepper bred for northern climates. Resists blossom end rot. Hybrid
red beauty	4" long very thick walled sweet red bell pepper. Heavy yielding and reliable. Hybrid
revolution	Extra large 4 lobed sweet red bell pepper. Early maturing and good disease resistance. Hybrid
sweet banana	6" long tapered sweet pepper. Ripens from light yellow to bright red. Good for frying and pickling.
aristotle	Thick-walled blocky bell peppers are 5"x4.5". Disease resistant. Hybrid
carmen	Italian "bull's horn" type frying pepper is 6"x2.5". Ripens to red. Thick-walled and productive. Hybrid.
lipstick	4" long heart-shaped peppers grow well in northern climates. Great in salads or roasted.
sweet pimento	Round and ribbed fruit are slightly flattened and ripen green to red. Heirloom
mellow star shishito	3-4" heavily wrinkled fruits have thin walls. Great for frying, grilled and sauteeing. Productive. Heirloom.

glaskin's perpetual	Non-bitter variety with greenish-red stems. Can be harvested its first year. Perennial. Heirloom.

table ace acorn	Delicious and compact acorn squash. Bright orange flesh and black-green skin, holds well in storage. Hybrid
butternut	Uniform 9" long 4-5 lb. fruits with light orange, sweet flesh. Flavor best after 2 months storage
spaghetti	When cooked, flesh makes strands like spaghetti. 4lb. fruit are ripe when deep gold color. 88 days to maturity
delicata	8"x3" 2lb. fruit are yellow and green striped. Sweet flesh great for baking and stuffing. 100 days to maturity
howden pumpkin	Produces 4-6 20-35lb. fruit/plant. Standard Jack-O-Lantern shape and color. 115 days to maturity
New England pie pumpkin	Sugar pie pumpkin averaging 5lbs. 102 days to maturity.

yellow crookneck	Deep yellow warted fruits with bulbous shape and curved neck. Very flavorful, best when picked young.
spineless beauty	No spines! Very uniform, dark green zucchini with great juicy flavor. Hybrid
slick pik yellow	Very early and prolific yellow squash. Best when picked young. Hybrid

<b>Basil</b>	
Genovese (Italian Sweet)	Large, green, aromatic and sweet leaves
Nufar (Italian Sweet)	Large, green, aromatic and sweet leaves. Good Disease resistance
Red Rubin	Very similar taste to Genovese, with vibrant purple color
Miniature Globe	Tiny leaves form a compact mound. Very sweet
Thai	Strong, spicy flavor similar to cloves. Purple flowers.
Lemon	Great lemon aroma and flavor
Holy (Tulsi)	Leaves and flowers have a hint of mint of cloves. Great for tea
<b>*Borage</b>	Fresh leaves and flowers have cucumber flavor. Great added to tea or fresh water. Beautiful blue flowers. Will self-seed.
<b>Bronze Fennel</b>	Licorice flavor and aroma, attractive ornamental and edible. Flowers attract pollinators. Self-seeding perennial
<b>*Catnip</b>	Not just for cats! Calming herb that also soothes the stomach. perennial that will self-seed.
<b>Chamomile - Roman</b>	Low growing and hardy with small white daisy-like blooms. Great for tea. Perennial
<b>Cilantro</b>	Popular in Mexican and Asian cooking, Prefers cooler temperatures. Seeds are coriander spice
<b>Chives</b>	Fine tubular stalks with mild onion flavor. Purple edible flowers are great for pollinators. Perennial
<b>Coriander- Vietnamese</b>	Relaxed mound of leaves similar to cilantro. Used in Asian and Vietnamese cooking.
<b>Dill</b>	Tall variety with early blooms, good for pollinators.
<b>*Feverfew</b>	Traditionally used as a headache remedy and fever reducer. Small, white daisy-like blooms. Perennial
<b>Lavender</b>	
Hidcote	One of the best culinary lavenders. Spikes of deep violet-blue flowers. Perennial
Munstead	Hardy variety that flowers earlier than most. Spikes of lavender-blue flowers great for oils, sachets and potpouris. Perennial
*Jean Davis	Upright lavender with pale pinkish-white flowers with excellent fragrance. It's a somewhat fruity tasting. Perennial
*Super Blue	English lavender with wonderfully aromatic flowers and leaves; outstanding in butterfly, herb or rock gardens. Perennial
<b>Lemon Grass - West Indian</b>	Zesty and lemon-like flavor and aroma. Used for tea and in Asian cooking.
<b>Lemon Verbena</b>	Strong lemon aroma and flavor. Great for tea and cooking. Needs to be pruned.
<b>Marjoram</b>	Mild fragrance, light purple flowers. Use fresh or dried. Pair with beef, poultry or in soup. Perennial
<b>*Meadowsweet</b>	Traditionally used to treat colds and coughs. Tufts of creamy-white fragrant flowers. Flowers have subtle almond flavor. Perennial

Chocolate	Low-growing growth habit, chocolate-peppermint patty aroma. Great in tea and jellies. Perennial
Mojito	The choice mint for mojitos, very distinct mint aroma and flavor. Perennial
Orange	Upright growth habit, orange citrus aroma and flavor. Great in fruit punch or dried for tea or potpourri. Perennial
Spearmint	Dense and upright, distinct spearmint aroma and flavor. Traditionally used for lamb sauce and juleps. Perennial
<b>Oregano</b>	
Greek	Densely mounded. More robust flavor and fragrance than other oreganos. Perennial
*Compactum	Dwarf creeping variety with intense flavor. Small pink flowers in the summer. Makes a nice ground cover. Perennial
*Variegated	Attractive ornamental oregano with green leaves with white-yellow margins and lilac flowers. Mild yet flavorful. Perennial
<b>Parsley</b>	
Italian Flat Leaf	Mild fragrance and rich flavor. Great fresh or dried.
Curly	Use fresh or dried. Curled and frilled leaves work well as a garnish. Also great for cooking
<b>Rosemary</b>	
Arp	Hardier than most varieties and very aromatic. Spikes of blue flowers.
Prostrate	Low-growing shrubby groundcover with the same great rosemary aroma and flavor.
Upright	Very popular variety with small-needle-like leaves. Spikes of violet-blue fragrant blooms in summer.
*Blue Spires	Upright rosemary variety with dense green leaves and stems topped with bright blue flower spikes. Great flavor
<b>Sage</b>	
Berggarten	Very popular variety with strong aroma and flavor. Light blue flowers bloom in early summer. Perennial
Pineapple	Upright, relaxed light green, pineapple-scented leaves. Striking red blooms. Great in tea. Perennial
Purple	Mounded and showy purple or purple tinged green aromatic leaves. Lilac-blue flowers. Perennial
<b>Scented Geraniums</b>	
Lemon	A favorite variety with distinct lemon scent. Annual
Citronella	Large leaved with pink flowers and lovely lemon scent. Annual
*Skullcap	Calming medicinal herb with upright growth habit and small blue flowers. Prefers wet environments. Perennial
Soapwort	Traditionally used for soapmaking, helps relieve itchiness. Round white flowes in summer. Perennial
Stevia	Intensely sweet leaves used as a sugar subsitute. Easy to grow. Tender perennial

French	Delightful licorice aroma and flavor. Use fresh or dried. Great with chicken and fish. Perennial
